CONSTUTUTION & BYLAWS

The following are proposed amendments to the Fairfax First Baptist Constitution and By-Laws and Church Wedding Policy. They have been reviewed and approved by the Board of Deacons and are to be voted on at the March business conference. The specific changes are shown by underlined text and are as follows:

Article IV. POLICY AND RELATIONSHIPS:

. . . We affirm the Southern Baptist belief that the Bible is the inerrant, infallible, and inspired word of God. <u>Our church affirms the Baptist Faith and</u> <u>Message as adopted by the Southern Baptist Con-</u> <u>vention, June 14, 2000.</u>

Article III.CHURCH STANDING COMMITTEES:

... All Standing Committees, with the exception of the Nominating Committee, shall be nominated by the Nominating Committee and elected by the church on or before the September business conference. <u>All committee terms shall begin on Janu-</u> <u>ary 1, and expire on December 31.</u>...

Section 2. CONFERENCES

The church shall hold regular business conferences monthly on the 2nd Sunday, except when there is a conflict <u>as may be determined by the deacons</u>. In the absence of the moderator, the chairman of deacons shall preside; . . .

CHURCH WEDDING POLICY

We believe the wedding ceremony to be one of the most sacred rites of the church. <u>Marriage is the</u> <u>uniting of one man and one woman in a covenant</u> <u>commitment for a lifetime. (This comes directly</u> <u>from the Baptist Faith and Message – June 14,</u> 2000). ...

Paragraph 2 & 3 are unchanged

<u>Those</u> who desire to use the church for the wedding ceremony shall consult the pastor and Board of Deacons for their approval. <u>The wedding must</u> <u>be consistent with the beliefs and values of our</u> church.
