Yet it was the will of the LORD to crush him; he has put him to grief; when his soul makes an offering for guilt, he shall see his offspring; he shall prolong his days; the will of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. Isaiah 53: 10

I remember hearing the story years ago about a man who took a job in the South operating a drawbridge over a river. One day, he brought his young son with him to work so he could see what his daddy did for a living. The two were talking when the man looked down at his watch and saw the 3:00pm train from Memphis was nearly due to arrive.

He was about to pull the lever when he saw something that horrified him. His son had wandered off and become caught in the gears that lowered the bridge.
