DISCIPLESHIP - GOD'S POWER

As wind causes eagles to soar, the wind of the Spirit enables us to soar. The Hebrew language in the Old Testament and the Greek language in the New Testament use the word *wind* for spirit. Jesus used the wind as an illustration when He said that we cannot anticipate where the Spirit of God will lead us any more than we can tell where the wind will blow (see John 3:8). I don't know where the wind of God's Spirit is moving in your life, but I know that He's moving all around this world. Open your wings and let the Spirit guide you with His gusts wherever He leads.

The Holy Spirit of God resides in every Christian, but many try to live by their own physical power. Jesus wants you to operate in the Holy Spirit, and He promised, "If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give he Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (Luke 11:13).

I once thought that effective Christian discipleship and service were the result of greater dedication and effort. But after trying to be more dedicated and working harder, I was in the depth of discouragement. At my lowest point God began to teach me about the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is given to us to teach, guide, empower, and use us for God's glory. I also learned that there is a difference in *having* the Spirit and *being filled* with the Spirit. Paul said, "Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit" (Ephesians 5:18). Most Christians insist on upholding the negative command of that verse not to be drunk with wine, but few Christians insist on the positive command to be filled with the Spirit
